

Combat Veteran Eligibility

Recently discharged Veterans who have served in combat locations since November 11, 1998 may be eligible for cost-free VA health care services for up to five years after their release from service for conditions possibly related to their combat service.

Free care refers to all services related to the Veteran's combat experience, even if there is insufficient medical evidence to conclude that such a condition is attributable to such service. Co-payments may be charged for the treatment of non-combat related conditions.

If a Veteran did not receive a complete dental exam from the military, then the Veteran is eligible to receive a dental exam from the VA. The Veteran must sign-up within 180 days of their discharge from active duty.
